

Music Angels Education Fund starts new year

A trio of fundraising events scheduled for first three months

VERO BEACH — Music Angels Education Fund will begin the new year with an ambitious and celebratory slate of fundraising events, marking the first time in the nonprofit's history that three major performances are being present- ed to kick off the season.

The events, scheduled for January, February and March will raise critical funds to support the organization's mis- sion of helping children pursue their musical interests through access to pri- vate lessons and instruments.

Founded by Linda Sposato, the Music Angels Education Fund provides music education opportunities to children who might not otherwise be able to af- ford them. All proceeds from the up- coming events will directly benefit Mu- sic Angels' programs.

The first event takes place on Jan. 15 with an evening of Latin music and dancing featuring La Herencia, a nine- piece traditional Latin band.

The performance will be held at the Heritage Center, 2140 14th Avenue in historic downtown Vero Beach. Doors open at 6 p.m., with music beginning at

6:30 p.m. and continuing through the evening. Guests will be welcomed with a complimentary drink, while lite bites will be available for purchase and a cash bar will be open throughout the night. Advance tickets are required and are \$45.

On Wednesday, Feb. 11, Music Angels will host a Dinner & Show event at Atmosphere at Vero, 1925 Old Dixie Highway. Beginning at 6 p.m., the eve-

-ning will feature performances by "The Dazzling Dynamic Duo" with vocal artist David Orson and pianist Gary Clark. Their show will include Broadway favor- ites, selections from the Great American Songbook and unexpected musical sur- prises. Tickets for the dinner and per- formance are \$120 per person and must be purchased in advance.

The third event will take place on March 25 with Jazz at the Museum, an encore performance by the Larry Brown Jazz Quartet.

The 7 p.m. concert will be at the Ma- jestic Theatre 11, 940 14th Lane in Vero Beach. The quartet is led by pianist Lar- ry Brown and featuring Dan Jordan, Dezmond Moss, and Warren. Advance tickets are \$45. Children and students are free.
